Class Procedures

Classes: Certification classes are designed to assist you with your preparation for CPIM, CSCP, CLTD and CTSC certification examinations. CPIM Introduction is an introductory class. All other classes are intended for people with either academic or on-the-job experience. Non CPIM/CSCP/CLTD/CTSC courses are general education not certification courses.

Exam Credits: Credits for the CPIM/CSCP/CLTD exams are good for 6 months from the date of exam credit issue. Please do not request a credit until you are ready to sit for the examination. ASCM Colorado Chapter honors requests for Exam Credits up to 2 years from date of certification course registration.

Refunds: All refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis and will be awarded at the discretion of the VP of Education.

Retakes: If you have taken a review class from us in the past 12 months and have not passed the corresponding examination, you can retake the class at no charge, otherwise class retakes are \$100. You will need to provide a copy of your ASCM Colorado Chapter class certificate and bring your book to class. Other re-take options will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Certificates of Recognition: Certificates are awarded on the basis of attendance.

Computer-Based Testing (CBT) Registration at Pearson VUE Test Centers: Registration requires a minimum of 48 hours up to 90 days in advance. Exams will be offered six days a week. **Visit the ASCM web site at www.ascm.org/certification to access a link to the secured Pearson VUE online registration site and obtain an Authorization to Test (ATT)**

Instructors: All instructors are qualified, experienced professionals and are ASCM Certified Instructors and participating in the ASCM Instructor Development Program (IDP).
